Pakistan and India have fought 3 wars, but since the possession of nuclear weapons by both countries, the relations have improved. Nuclear weapons have thus become deterrents of war rather than instigators of war. World wars witnesses unprecedented catastrophes which are initiated not by nuclear weapons but by the hideous minds of people.

There are some disadvantages of possessing nuclear weapons. Nuclear weapons may have not resulted in a war till now, but if a war abrupt nuclear weapons would do unprecedented damage. There nuclear weapons have been a cause of tense relations between different countries.

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
